

2024 TUITION FEE SCHEDULE

College tuition fees include the provision of textbooks, excursions, camps, technology and laptop computers for students.

A separate charge will be applied for voluntary programs such as Music Technology, private music tuition, hire of musical instruments, overseas and national study, cultural and sporting tours and TAFE and university programs. See overleaf for further details of other charges.

PAYMENT OPTIONS AND DUE DATES

The College offers three payment options including one annual payment at the commencement of the College year, payment by the term or payment in smaller instalments through Edstart. Each payment option is explained in more detail below.

ANNUAL PAYMENT

An annual payment discount of 3% is available for net tuition fees paid annually in advance by the due date. This discount is applied after all other concessions.

TERM PAYMENT

Tuition fees are invoiced in four instalments in line with the school terms, except for Year 12 which is invoiced in three instalments over terms 1 to 3. Due dates are as follows:

PAYMENT PLANS

The College has engaged Edstart to provide a finance solution to families who may wish to pay tuition fees in smaller, more regular instalments (eg weekly, fortnightly or monthly). Edstart offers payment plans for school fees and other education costs with no transaction fees. Further information can be found at edstart.com.au/chac.

DISCOUNTS

ANNUAL PAYMENT DISCOUNT

For annual fee payers only, an annual payment discount of 3% is offered where the annual tuition fee is paid **IN FULL** by 1 February 2024.

DUE DATE DISCOUNT FOR TERM PAYMENTS

For term fee payer only, a due date discount of \$50 per student per term is offered where payment of the outstanding balance is received **IN FULL** by the due date stated on the fee statement.

FAMILY DISCOUNT

A family discount is offered where two or more children concurrently attend the College and for whom no other concession applies, as follows:

OTHER CHARGES

OTHER PROGRAMS, ACTIVITIES, SUBSCRIPTIONS AND OPTIONAL CHARGES

Tuition fees do not cover the following programs/activities/subscriptions and separate charges will be applied for:

- Year 6 Primary Tour (approximately \$1,000). This amount will be invoiced in three instalments in line with tuition fee statements: Term 1 = \$350, Term 2 = \$350, Term 3 = balance payable.
- Private Music Tuition
- Hire of Musical Instruments
- Music Technology Course and Music Theory
- Overseas and National Study, Cultural and Sporting Tours
- Distance Education Courses, Traineeships, TAFE Courses and University programs
- Voluntary Tax-Deductible Donations. A voluntary tax-deductible donation of \$95 per term will be included on the Tuition Fee Statement. Parents may opt to pay this voluntary tax -deductible donation as part of their tuition fee payment.

Tuition fees do not cover student stationery items. Booklists for each year level are available through [Schoolstuff](#).

NOTIFICATION OF INTENTION TO LEAVE

In accordance with the Enrolment Agreement, at least one full term's notice, in writing, must be given of a student's intention to leave the College. Failure to provide such notice will result in a withdrawal fee equivalent to one term's tuition fees being payable. A 'term' is defined as the dates specified in the Annual College Calendar. For example, notification of intention to leave at the **end** of Term 4 would be required **prior** to the date of **commencement** of Term 4.

ADMINISTRATION FEE

A monthly administration fee of \$150 may be charged on overdue accounts where no acceptable payment arrangement is in place. Non-payment of tuition fees may also result in legal action and the student being excluded from the College.
