Permitted works:

In accordance with the criteria for considering applications made under the *Natural Assets Local Law 2003* (the Local Law) and subject to the conditions contained on the subsequent pages of this document, you are permitted to carry out the following works described in your application dated 9 FEBRUARY 2023:

Removal of THIRTY-EIGHT (38) assorted native trees [identified as Trees 163, 164, 173, 177, 179, 186, 190, 191, 197, 201, 204, 205, 218, 219, 232, 239, 240, 244, 246, 247, 258, 267, 272, 277, 287, 288, 297, 298, 303, 304, 308, 312, 313, 316, 317, 318, 322 and 423],
AND

Root zone interference within the Tree Protection Zone (TPZ) of THREE (3) Weeping fig (*Ficus benjamina*) [identified as Trees 019, 020 and 021] and THREE (3) Broad-leaved paperbark (*Melaleuca quinquenervia*) [identified as Trees 279, 289 and 295], located on the premises, 189 JUNCTION RD CANNON HILL QLD 4170, as indicated in your application.

This interference is permitted to allow for construction of new tennis courts and a new carpark under a Ministerial Infrastructure Designation (MID-1221-0561). This permit remains in force until the expiry date, unless surrendered, suspended, or revoked.
